Sheet Metal Journeyman (Temporary) Competition #: AF-2017-046

Acden Facilities LP. is currently accepting applications for one (1) temporary Alberta Journeyman or Interprovincial Red Seal Sheet Metal tradesperson to support our oil sands client. This position is located at CNRL Horizon site. Flight and camp accommodation will be provided from designated hubs; Edmonton and Calgary. This position will consist of a 7 on/ 7 off rotation of day shifts; covering 80 hours per shift cycle. However, hours and schedules may change due to operational requirements. This is a temporary position and may end on or before three (3) months of commencement.

The Sheet Metal tradesperson will report to the HVAC Foreperson and Superintendent. The Sheet Metal tradesperson will interact closely with the building operators, planning group, trades and all divisions on site; both internal to Acden Facilities and external (client and contractors).

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Examine and interpret engineering and architectural drawings, sketches and work specifications that require to be performed, along with the lay out, measurements and mark sheet metals per drawings or templates.
- Develop patterns/templates for sheet metal using computer-assisted design and drafting (CAD) software package.
- Operate light metal working machines, including: shears, brakes, punches, and drill presses, and computer numerical control (CNC) equipment to cut, bend, punch, drill, shape or straighten sheet metal.
- Operate computerized laser or plasma cutting equipment to cut sheet metal.
- Install and use rigging and hoisting equipment.
- Fit and join sheet metal parts using riveting, welding, soldering and similar equipment to fabricate products such as ventilation shafts, exhaust hoods, eaves troughs, partition frames, air and heat ducts, material handling systems, roof decking and sheet metal buildings.
- Install sheet metal products per specifications and building codes.
- Grind and buff seams, joints and rough surfaces.
- Inspect product quality and installation to ensure conformance to specifications.

Qualifications:

- Certified Journeyman Sheet Metal
- One (1) to three (3) years' experience (industrial maintenance/construction environment preferred)
- Combination of education and experience may be considered.
- Valid Class 5 Driver's License, with a five (5) clean abstract (less than thirty (30) days).
- Must be able to work from heights or confined spaces.
- Highly developed organizational and communication skills, both written and verbal.





- Excellent Problem Solving Skills.
- Highly developed interpersonal skills and ability to work harmoniously with a diverse workforce.
