These positions will consist of 7 on/ 7 off rotations, consisting of day shifts; covering 80 hours per shift cycle, however hours and schedules may change due to operational requirements.

**Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Assist various Journeyman Trades personnel as required
- Replace filters in all HVAC units in camps
- Complete routine work order requests for filter replacement
- Deliver supplies and materials
- Communicate directly with HVAC technicians, site coordinators, fire hall personnel, and external control systems technicians.
- Complete various other duties as they may arise that would fulfill mandate of providing complete facilities operations and maintenance.
