Duties and Responsibilities:

- Install, repair and adjust various types of mechanical equipment such as pumps, compressors, pulleys and all other mechanical components and auxiliary equipment.
- Complete routine self-generated and work order requests for repairs and services.
- Respond to emergencies.
- Perform all required preventative maintenance on mechanical systems and components.
- Apply all codes to preventative maintenance and repairs.
