Duties and Responsibilities:

- Determine required equipment and welding method, applying knowledge of metallurgy, geometry and welding techniques.
- Weld components in flat, vertical, overhead and any "out-of-position" angle.
- Apply advanced skills in procedures, techniques, tools, materials and/or equipment as appropriate to area of specialization.
- Perform all work in compliance with established safety procedures and codes.
- Other fabrication duties as required.

Qualifications:

- Alberta Certified Journeyman Welder (Red Seal Certification with CWB is preferred).
- Minimum of 3-5 years of welding experience.
- Ability to read and interpret basic blue prints.
- Experienced Fabrication welding required.
- Experience with Heavy Equipment repairs is required.
- Cooper Heat experience is required.
